HUD releases CoC Program NOFA (Notice of Funding Availability) for fiscal year and local CoC publishes local timeline and deadlines

Nov. 13

Applicants submit new or renewal project applications in e-snaps (HUD's grant application platform)

Dec. 15

Community's Rank & Review
Committee prioritizes projects
based on performance evaluation
strategic resource allocation, and
community impact

Dec. 30

Prioritization list of new and renewal projects is submitted to HUD alongside community's Consolidated Application

Jan. 14

HUD makes all final funding determinations based on project review, community's application score, and project prioritization list

May 1

### General Information



- 2-year NOFO promised last year voided
- Changes to funding tiers, prioritization, review criteria
- Funding components: 1) Transitional Housing 2) Supportive Services Only
   3) Permanent Housing (this includes PSH and RRH) 4) HMIS
- \$3.9B in funding available increase from \$3.5B last year

Project Application Deadline is December 15, 2025





- Nonprofit organizations (this includes religious organizations)
- States, local governments, and instrumentalities of State or local governments

### **HUD** Priorities



- Ending the crisis of homelessness on our streets (focused on unsheltered)
- 2. Prioritizing Treatment and Recovery
- 3. Advancing Public Safety
- 4. Promoting Self-Sufficiency
- 5. Improving Outcomes
- 6. Minimizing Trauma

### Key Changes



- Permanent Housing Cap: No more than 30% of a CoC's funding can support RRH, PSH, or Joint TH-RRH.
- Mandatory Services: TH programs are incentivized to require 40 hours/week of structured services.
- Eligibility Restrictions: PSH eligibility limited to individuals with physical or developmental disabilities or older adults.
- Restrictions on DEI and Gender-Inclusive Practices: Language commonly used in evidence-based, trauma-informed work may reduce scoring.
- Merit Review Overhaul: New scoring criteria will disadvantage many high-performing programs.

FY24 PH Project totaled \$647,358 or roughly 84% of the total NOFO Award






- Tier 1 = the amount equal to 30% of ARD
  - All projects except Planning must be ranked
  - All Tier 1 Project that meet eligibility and risk review requirements will be funded
- Tier 2 = the amount equal to the sum of remaining ARD+ CoC Bonus+ DV Bonus
  - Projects in Tier 2 will go through Threshold, Merit, and Risk Reviews




