HUD releases CoC Program NOFA (Notice of Funding Availability) for fiscal year and local CoC publishes local timeline and deadlines

Applicants submit new or renewal project applications in e-snaps (HUD's grant application platform)

Community's Rank & Review Committee prioritizes projects based on performance evaluation, strategic resource allocation, and community impact

Prioritization list of new and renewal projects is submitted to HUD alongside community's Consolidated Application

HUD makes all final funding determinations based on project review, community's application score, and project prioritization list



## General Information



- Permanent Housing (PSH & RRH), Transitional Housing, SSO, Transition Grants
- \$4,040,000,000 in funding available with designated priorities (\$1.3B for New Projects)
- Transition Grants available for reallocation

Local Project Application

Deadline is July 20, 2026



## Eligible Project Applicants

- Nonprofit organizations (this includes religious organizations)
- States, local governments, and instrumentalities of State or local governments

### Project Requirements:

- CoC Membership
- HMIS implementation



## ▶ Funding and HUD Policy Priorities

- Improving outcomes – reducing homelessness, self-sufficiency
- Creating competition
- Restoring balance to CoCs
- Prioritizing treatment and recovery
- Promoting economic self-sufficiency
- Advancing public safety
- Minimizing trauma for vulnerable populations
- Expanding access based on merit

**HUD review will consist of a Threshold Review, Merit Review, and Risk Review**

# HUD Conditional Project Selection

1.

All CoC Planning and UFA Costs applications that meet project threshold requirements.

2.

All projects ranked in Tier 1 that meet project threshold requirements. Can include any type of project, new or renewal, including DV Bonus.

3.

If DV Bonus ranked in Tier 1 = \$104 million, no further action needed; If total does not = \$104 million, select DV bonus by project score in Tier 2 up to \$104 million  
DV Bonus ranked in Tier 2 > \$104 million *may* still be selected based on project score using steps below

4.

If PH projects for families with children ranked in Tier 1 = \$430 million, no further action needed; if total does not = \$430 million, select PH projects for families with children by project score in Tier 2 up to \$430 million  
PH projects for families with children ranked in Tier 2 > \$430 million *may* still be selected based on project score using steps below

5.

**New** TH and SSO projects **ranked in Tier 2** by project score (could include DV Bonus for TH and SSO not already selected) until \$1.3 billion of new projects selected

6.

(If funds available) Other types of **new** projects **ranked in Tier 2** by project score until the \$1.3 billion amount has been reached. Once \$1.3 billion in new projects has been reached, HUD will remove any remaining unselected new projects

7.

(If funds available) HUD will select renewal projects ranked in Tier 2 that meet project threshold requirements by Tier 2 score until all remaining available funds have been expended.



# FL-505 Project Prioritization

- Tier 1 – HUD mandated service delivery renewals (SSO-CE & HMIS)
- Tier 2 – Permanent Supportive Housing (new or renewal)
- Tier 3 – DV Bonus Projects
- Tier 4 – Permanent Housing Projects (PSH/RRH) for families with children
- Tier 5 – NEW Transitional Housing or SSO Projects
- Tier 6 – Other types of NEW Projects (Permanent Housing, Transition, Reallocation)
- Tier 7 – All remaining renewal projects



# Ranking and Review

- Tier 1 = the amount equal to 60% of ARD
- Tier 2 = the amount equal to the sum of remaining ARD+ CoC Bonus+ DV Bonus



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Welcome to **e-snaps**! The application and grants management system for HUD's Continuum of Care (CoC) Program. This system supports the CoC Consolidated Application – CoC Application, CoC Priority Listing, and project applications for the CoC Program Competition. It also supports the Technical Submission process for project applications conditionally selected for award.

The **e-snaps** system is to be used by authorized persons only. If you are an authorized user, please log in by entering a valid user name and password. If you have any difficulty with this process, please contact the System Administrator. You may also use the Links on the left menu to navigate through the system, and access application forms and other related links. If you need assistance in navigating the system, please access the Help instructions in each section.

If you are not an authorized user and need access to **e-snaps** on behalf of your Continuum of Care as a Collaborative Applicant or project applicant, you may request a user name through the Registration process.

The information collection requirements contained in this application were submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for review under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (44 U.S.C. 3501-3520). This agency may not collect this information, and you are not required to complete this form, unless it displays a valid OMB control number with expiration date.

Information is submitted in accordance with the statutory and regulatory authority for the CoC Program. The information will be used to register CoCs, review and assess eligibility and quality threshold rate of applications, select and conditionally award CoC Program grants.

Selection of applications for funding under the Continuum of Care Program are based on rating factors established in the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO), published annually to announce the Continuum of Care Program Competition. The information collected in the application form will only be collected in accordance with each year's Competition.

Public reporting burden for this collection is estimated to average 3 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information.

**CoC Program Application:** OMB Approval No. 2506-0112 (exp. 12/31/2024)

Public reporting burden for this collection of information is estimated to average 190 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information. The reporting burden for Continuums of Care is estimated to average 204 hours and the reporting burden for applicants is expected to average 30 hours.

**Technical Submission:** OMB Approval No. 2506-0183 (10/31/2026)

Public reporting burden for the collection of information is estimated to average 10 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information.

**Annual Performance Reporting:** OMB Approval No. 2506-0145 (01/31/2025)
